Types of courses


- Lectures: Usually no registration, no compulsory attendance (exceptions possible!)
- Tutorials: Information on registration usually announced in the first lecture session; mostly compulsory attendance
- Seminars: Online application necessary (application period already mostly over, cf. our information mail); exceptions by directly contact with the professors/instructors; compulsory attendance
