# 11th Student's Symposium: Research Topics and Intercultural Learning in the International Context (May 21-29 2023)

### May 22, 2023 (Monday): Opening Session of 11th Student's Symposium

On Monday, May 22, 2023 the 11th student symposium: Research and intercultural learning in an international context was opened. Before the beginning of the symposium, it was necessary to register.
